You could be part of this exceptional team, contributing to the cleanliness and comfort of our hospice. With 14 bedrooms, 4 family flats, a conference center, swimming pool area, therapy and activity rooms, lounges, social areas, bathrooms, toilet facilities, a dining room, offices, and a welcoming main entrance, there's plenty to take pride in and make a difference.

Typical tasks the role could involve:

- **Conscientious Cleaner:** Unleash the power of our vacuum cleaners to banish every speck of dust and debris, leaving floors pristine and inviting, making way for a new day!
- **Marvelous Mopper:** Wield our mops with precision and finesse, conquering grime and leaving behind a trail of sparkling triumph!

References & DBS Check: As Rainbows is committed to ensuring the safeguarding and wellbeing of the people we work with; you will also be asked to provide two satisfactory character references to support your application. Rainbows will also process an Enhanced DBS check before you can start.

- Staff will be available at all times to provide support, advice and guidance.
